




# WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN?





**What is your age?** (n = 231)




**How would you describe your gender?** (n = 230)

**33% -** Man


**2%** - Non-binary/gender non-conforming

**Please select all that describe you.** (n = 363)





Focus on becoming a **complete**, **multigenerational**, **and multi-cultural community**.




Encourage more restaurant, shopping, and entertainment options.

Spur housing options that are affordable for people at all incomes and life stages.




Strengthen the local economy through economic development and diversification.



Foster a strong relationship between Miami University and the greater community.



# WHAT IS SMART GROWTH?

#### Ten Principles

- 1. Mix land uses.
- 2. Take advantage of compact design.
- 3. Create a range of housing opportunities and choices.
- 4. Create walkable neighborhoods.
- 5. Foster distinctive, attractive communities with a strong sense of place.
- 6. Preserve open space, farmland, natural beauty, and critical environmental areas.
- 7. Direct development towards existing communities.
- 8. Provide a variety of transportation choices.
- 9. Make development decisions predictable, fair, and cost effective.
- 10. Encourage community and stakeholder collaboration in development decisions.
